

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Fiscal Year 2012 Tohono O'odham Department of Health and
Human Services, Division of Community Health-Department of Justice,
Violence Against Women Grants to Indian Tribal Governments)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-336

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Management of Health Division**
2 **coordinates services provision for its ten divisions; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded Grant No. 2010-TW-AX-0020 from the**
4 **Department of Justice for a three year grant project period 10/01/10 – 09/30/13 to**
5 **provide crisis intervention for Tohono O'odham women who are victims/survivors of**
6 **domestic violence and educate the community on domestic violence, dating violence,**
7 **sexual assault and stalking; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Violence Against Women was awarded \$900,000.00 and is in its second year of**
9 **implementation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, a budget of \$300,000.00 has been prepared for Fiscal Year 2012; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**
12 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
13 **adoption.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts,**
15 **approves and authorizes:**

- 16 **1. A budget of \$300,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2012 attached hereto and incorporated**
17 **herein is approved and authorized to expend accordingly by the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Legislative Council.**
- 19 **2. To utilize the Nations Resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the**
20 **continuation of the Grant.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
23 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
24 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21st Day**
26 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
28 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
