

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the 2012 budget for account 11-1136 a federal grant administered by the
Office of Violence against Women from the Recovery Act Grants to Indian Tribal
Governments Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-340

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of the Prosecutor has successfully applied for and**
2 **received an award administered by the Office on Violence against Women (OVW) from**
3 **the Recovery Act Grants to Indian Tribal Governments Program funded through the**
4 **US Department of Justice(DOJ) for the amount of \$899,983.00 under grant number**
5 **2009-EG-S6-0030 the grant amount is funding for a three year period beginning**
6 **October 1st, 2009 through September 30th, 2012; and**

7 **WHEREAS, these funds will be used to fund a dedicated prosecutorial team expanding the**
8 **prosecutorial focus to increasing accountability for Sexual Assault (SA) while**
9 **continuing our committed focus on Domestic Violence (DV) and to explore the**
10 **protocols and sustain ability of a Sexual Assault Response Team; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the budget for FY 2012 (Oct. 1st, 2011 through Sept. 30th, 2012) in the amount of**
12 **\$265,353.15 for said grant has been put in tribal format and is before the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Legislative Council for review; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the items being budgeted for are estimated and may be adjusted at a later date if**
15 **needed; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the program will file for a no cost extension from OVW for the balance to be used for**
17 **October 1st, 2012 through September 30th, 2013, as appropriate; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the**
19 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
20 **adoption.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
22 **and approves the FY 2012 Budget in the amount of \$265,353.15 and to utilize the**
23 **Nations Resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of**
24 **the grant.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the**
26 **third year's budget, attached here, for FY2012 beginning October 1, 2011 through**
27 **September 30th, 2012; in the amount of \$265,353.15.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
29 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
30 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
31 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
