

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Clean Air Act Proposal and Approval of the FY 2012 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-346

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment and**
2 **safe guarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and**

3 **WHEREAS, in the past and present, air quality issues have threatened the environment, health**
4 **and well-being, and the sovereignty of the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Environmental Protection Office (EPO) has submitted a**
6 **proposal to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Clean Air Act (CAA)**
7 **program in the amount of \$85,000.00 for continued funding to support air quality**
8 **activities; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act grant would allow the Nation to finalize the Point Source Emissions**
10 **Inventory and Needs Assessment, develop a Monitoring Plan; develop a Quality**
11 **Assurance Project Plan and participation in local, regional and national initiatives;**
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the**
14 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
15 **adoption.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
17 **the FY2012 proposal in the amount of \$85,000.00 and to utilize the Nations Resources**
18 **pending reimbursement from the Grantor for continued funding for the grant.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**
20 **expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from October**
21 **1, 2011 to September 30, 2012.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
23 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
25 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22nd Day**
27 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
29 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
