

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office FY - 2012
TERO/EEOC Budget 13-1070)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-347

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**
2 **1978; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is to increase**
4 **employment of Indians on and near the Tohono O'odham Nation by enforcing Indian**
5 **Preference in employment, training, contracting, subcontracting and eradicate**
6 **employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham**
7 **Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office has been**
9 **supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the amount of**
10 **\$26,000.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Nation requires the Tohono O'odham Nation to accept contract funds**
13 **without including indirect cost.**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee of the**
15 **Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**
16 **adoption.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
18 **and approves the FY 2012 proposal in the amount of \$26,000.00 without including**
19 **indirect cost and to utilize the Nations Resources pending reimbursement from the**
20 **Grantor for the continuation of Tribal Employment Rights Office.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby waives the Indirect**
22 **Cost requirement for the EEOC Budget.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October 1, 2011**
24 **through September 30, 2012.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
26 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
27 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
28 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22nd Day**
30 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
31 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
32 **(d)(2)(3)&(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
33 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
34 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
35 **Stat. 984).**
