

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2012 Department of Health and Human Services Head Start Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-348**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**  
2 **Department of Health and Human Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Head**  
4 **Start Program to provide educational, health, mental health and parent involvement**  
5 **services to children, three to five years of age; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Human Resources Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee**  
7 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval and**  
8 **adoption.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**  
10 **and approves the FY 2012: Head Start Program Budget - \$1,524,913.00 + \$148,854.00**  
11 **(IDC) = \$1,673,767.00 and Head Start T & TA Budget- \$23,205.00 (IDC not in Budget) and**  
12 **to utilize the Nations Resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the**  
13 **continuation of the grants.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
15 **Executive Branch to expend funds for the program listed above and as attached in the**  
16 **amount indicated, effective November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2012.**

- 17 **1. Head Start Program Budget - \$1,524,913.00 + \$148,854.00 (IDC) = \$1,673,767.00**  
18 **2. Head Start T & TA Budget- \$23,205.00 (IDC not in Budget).**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budgets as**  
21 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day**  
24 **of JULY, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**  
26 **(d)(2)(3)&(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
