(Approving Budget Amendment #2/budget Modification #2 for Artesia-Little
Tucson FY 2011 Budget)

1 **WHEREAS, at a special session of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, held in July of 2011;**
2 **and**

3 **WHEREAS, Baboquivari District Representatives brought forward a budget amendment #2/**
4 **budget modification #2 for Artesia-Little Tucson's FY 2011 budget; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the budget amendment #2 is to add 5 additional youth worker positions under the**
6 **610.00 Salaries line item; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the budget modification #2 will utilize the savings from the vacant labor position, to**
8 **cover the salaries for the 5 youth workers in the amount of \$9,240.00 and will utilize**
9 **the savings from the labor position under fringe benefits to cover the fringe benefits**
10 **for the 5 youth workers in the amount of \$1,016.40; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the budget modification #1 will affect the line items listed below as follows;**

15 **WHEREAS, this amendment #2/modification #2 does not affect the current FY 2011 budget**
16 **amount of \$188,333.65 for Artesia-Little Tucson communities, nor will it affect the**
17 **overall Baboquivari District's FY 2011 budget of \$1,721,382.80; and**

18 **WHEREAS, after review and discussion, the budget amendment #2/modification #2 for Artesia-**
19 **Little Tucson's FY 2011 current budget was approved.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **budget amendment #2, which creates 5 youth worker positions and budget**
22 **modification #2 to decrease and increase the above mentioned line items.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this budget amendment #2/modification #2 will not affect the**
24 **Artesia-Little Tucson's FY 2011 current budget of \$188,333.65, nor will it affect the**
25 **overall Baboquivari District's FY 2011 current budget of \$1,721,382.80.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any modifications, amendments, or changes in the justifications**
27 **shall be reviewed and approved by the Budget & Finance Committee and the Tohono**
28 **O'odham Legislative Council.**
