

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Appointing Representative Cynthia Manuel to the National Congress of American Indians**  
**Workgroup on Reporting, Accountability, and Auditing and Appointing Representative**  
**Olivia Villegas-Liston as the Nation's Alternate)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-374**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**  
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation with Federal, State**  
3 **and local governments and other Indian tribes . . . or with private persons or**  
4 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O’odham Council”**  
5 **(Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (“NCAI”), a national organization serving**  
7 **the broad interests of tribal governments and communities, has formed several**  
8 **national workgroups consisting of tribal leaders to advise and work with the Bureau**  
9 **of Indian Affairs (“BIA”) on issues affecting American Indians nationwide; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the NCAI has established a national Workgroup on Reporting, Accountability, and**  
11 **Auditing to advise the BIA on how to develop a consistent reporting format in order to**  
12 **more readily identify unmet needs, justify increased appropriations to tribes, and**  
13 **provide accountability to the United States Congress on the use of such funds; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has previously appointed representatives from the Budget and**  
15 **Finance Committee to the Workgroup and it is in the best interest of the Tohono**  
16 **O’odham Nation to continue participating in the NCAI Workgroup on Reporting,**  
17 **Accountability, and Auditing; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee recommends appointing Representative Cynthia**  
19 **Manuel as the Tohono O’odham Nation’s representative to the NCAI Workgroup on**  
20 **Reporting, Accountability, and Auditing and Representative Olivia Villegas-Liston as**  
21 **Representative Manuel's alternate.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**  
23 **Representative Cynthia Manuel as the Tohono O’odham Nation’s representative to the**  
24 **NCAI Workgroup on Reporting, Accountability, and Auditing and appoints**  
25 **Representative Olivia Villegas-Liston as Representative Manuel’s alternate; provided**  
26 **that an appointment made pursuant to this resolution (1) shall supersede any prior**  
27 **appointments to the NCAI Workgroup on Reporting, Accountability, and Auditing and**  
28 **(2) shall expire if the appointee is no longer serving on the Legislative Budget and**  
29 **Finance Committee for any reason.**
