

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Appointing Representative Olivia Villegas-Liston as the Nation's Intertribal**  
**Monitoring Association on Indian Trust Funds Representative and**  
**Representative Frances Miguel as the Nation's Alternate)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-375**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**  
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation with Federal, State**  
3 **and local governments and other Indian tribes . . . or with private persons or**  
4 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O’odham Council”**  
5 **(Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section I(f)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Nation is a charter member of the Intertribal Monitoring**  
7 **Association on Indian Trust Funds (“ITMA”); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the ITMA’s mission is to focus on trust fund and asset management initiatives by**  
9 **monitoring the government’s reform efforts, trust policies and regulations, legislative**  
10 **and litigation initiatives, providing a forum for tribal consultation, providing**  
11 **increased education for tribes and individuals, enforcing the federal government to**  
12 **adhere and implement trust standards, and empowering tribes and individuals to**  
13 **control and manage their own trust funds and assets (ITMA’s Mission Statement); and**

14 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O’odham that the Nation continue its**  
15 **participation in the ITMA and its consultations with ITMA member tribes in order to**  
16 **hold the federal government accountable for its many decades of Indian trust asset**  
17 **mismanagement; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee, which has been delegated authority to**  
19 **recommend legislative measures concerning the use of funds held in trust by the**  
20 **federal government, has recommended the appointment of Representative Olivia**  
21 **Villegas-Liston as the Nation’s ITMA representative and Representative Frances**  
22 **Miguel as the Nation’s ITMA alternate (Plan of Operation for Budget & Finance**  
23 **Committee, Article I(b)(4)).**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**  
25 **Representative Olivia Villegas-Liston as the Nation’s ITMA representative and**  
26 **Representative Frances Miguel as the Nation’s ITMA alternate; provided that an**  
27 **appointment made by this resolution (1) shall supersede any prior ITMA appointments**  
28 **and (2) shall expire if the appointee is no longer serving on the Budget and Finance**  
29 **Committee for any reason.**






