

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing Amendment #3 of KOHN 91.9 FM's Corporation for
Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant increasing the budget from
\$267,020.38 to \$268,433.32)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-385

1 **WHEREAS, Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) has provided notice to the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation of the final allocation amount for KOHN's Rural Listener Access**
3 **Incentive Fund (RLAIF) portion of its CPB grant; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the final allocation provides an increase of \$1,412.94 over the estimate used for budget**
5 **purposes; and**

6 **WHEREAS, KOHN has prepared an amendment to the FY 2011 CPB grant budget, attached and is**
7 **incorporated into this resolution by this reference, to obligate the increased funding;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, KOHN has identified emergency repairs for its back up power generator, and has re-**
10 **allocated funds from existing available funds to provide for these repairs; and**

11 **WHEREAS, KOHN has presented amendment #3 to the Executive Office, Culture Preservation**
12 **Committee, and Budget and Finance Committee for review and approval.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
14 **approve amendment #3 of KOHN's Corporation for Public Broadcasting grant,**
15 **incorporated into this resolution by this reference, to obligate the additional funds**
16 **allocated for the Rural Listener Access Incentive Fund portion of the grant, increasing**
17 **the budget from \$267,020.38 to \$268,433.32.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendment #3 provides for the allocation of funds for KOHN's**
19 **emergency repair of the station generator under account 770 - Repair and**
20 **Maintenance Equipment; additional fund allocation to 750 - Capital for anticipated**
21 **increase in shipping costs.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend KOHN's**
23 **Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant funds in accordance**
24 **with the attached budget for the remaining term of Corporation for Public**
25 **Broadcasting's spending authorization through September 30, 2011.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Nation's officials to-wit the Chairman or any other designated**
27 **official are hereby authorized to execute any agreement necessary to expend the grant**
28 **funds provided that any amendments affecting the grant funds or funding level shall**
29 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**


1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day
