

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the FY 2011 budget Amendment No. 4 and Onetime Funding Amounts**  
**and Recurring Amounts for the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department**  
**638 Corrections Program from \$5,486,140.86 to \$5,847,641.52)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-392**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**  
2 **Corrections Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) Corrections program has**  
4 **received from the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and increase of funding under**  
5 **modification No. 137 in the amount of \$284,496.00 which is reoccurring and a onetime**  
6 **funding modification No. 176 in the amount of \$14,017.00 and a onetime funding**  
7 **modification No. 177 in the amount of \$10,938.00 for total amount of \$309,451.00; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the TONPD Corrections program has added five positions to the 638 Budget for One**  
9 **Corrections Sergeant, One Corrections Officer, one Corrections Cook and two**  
10 **Corrections Support Specialist for total increase to salary line item of \$170,217.60,**  
11 **Other Compensation at \$10,213.00 and Fringe Benefits at \$58,639.96 for total increase**  
12 **to salaries in the amount of \$239,070.62; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the TONPD Corrections Program has also increased several line items 710 Utilities,**  
14 **712 Gas, Oil & Coolants, 721 Supplies Other, 722 Program Supplies, 723 Uniforms and**  
15 **770 Repair & Maintenance of Equipment; and**

16 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment no. 4 has increased the current budget from \$5,486,140.86 to**  
17 **\$5,847,641.52 a difference of \$309,451.00 with Indirect Cost at \$52,049.66 a total of**  
18 **\$361,500.66; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the FY 2011 638 Corrections Program Budget Amendment No. 4 has been reviewed by**  
20 **the Budget Office, the Grants & Contracts Office, the Executive Office, and the**  
21 **Legislative Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees, all of which**  
22 **recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
24 **approves and authorizes Budget Amendment No. 4 for the TONPD Corrections**  
25 **Program as follows, received from the BIA modification No. 137 in the amount of**  
26 **\$284,496.00 reoccurring, onetime funding modification No. 176 in the amount of**  
27 **\$14,017.00 and onetime funding modification No. 177 in the amount of \$10,938.00 for**  
28 **total amount of \$309,451.00. Has increased personnel by adding 5 positions changing**  
29 **personnel cost by \$239,070.62. Increased line items under Operational as follows, line**

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
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1 item 710 Utilities, 712 Gas, Oil & Coolants, 721 Supplies Other, 722 Program Supplies,  
2 723 Uniforms and 770 Repair & Maintenance of Equipment. Total increase to the 638  
3 Corrections Program Budget is \$361,500.66 with an increase to the Indirect Cost of  
4 \$52,049.66 changing budget from \$5,486,140.86 to \$5,847,641.52.

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the  
6 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as  
7 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be  
8 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.


9 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day

13 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
14 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
15 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






