

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant Strategic Plan)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-397

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority “to promote, protect and provide**
2 **for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono**
3 **O’odham Nation and its members” (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation’s Department of Health and Human Services Division of Management of**
5 **Health directs health services that provide substance abuse, mental health, and**
6 **prevention services to the Nation’s members; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Division of Management of Health submitted an application and received a grant**
8 **in the amount of \$600,800 per year for five years from the U. S. Department of Health**
9 **and Human Service Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration**
10 **(“SAMHSA”) for a Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant (“SPF TIG”);**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, by Resolutions No. 09-503, 10-198, and 11-240, the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council**
13 **authorized the acceptance of the grant and authorized the Tohono O’odham**
14 **Department of Health and Human Services to expend grant funds and to administer**
15 **the grant; and**

16 **WHEREAS, SAMHSA’s SPF TIG requires the development and implementation of the Tohono**
17 **O’odham Nation’s Strategic Plan to establish evidence-based prevention programs**
18 **within the districts with a goal of reducing alcohol and substance abuse; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Division of Management of Health has completed the SPF TIG Strategic Plan; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the SPF TIG Tribal Advisory Council and the Legislative Health and Human Services**
21 **Committee reviewed the Strategic Plan.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it supports**
23 **the Tohono O’odham Nation Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant**
24 **Strategic Plan 2011-2013, which the Tohono O’odham Department of Health and**
25 **Human Services is authorized to submit to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health**
26 **Services Administration, implement, administer, and amend in accordance with SPF**
27 **TIG requirements.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Department of Health and Human**
29 **Services will administer the SPF TIG Strategic Plan with participation from the**
30 **Nation’s districts; provided that no district shall expend district funds except pursuant**



1 to budgets approved by the Tohono O'odham Council in accordance with the Nation's
2 Constitution.

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that nothing in this resolution shall be interpreted as an exercise of the
4 Legislative Council's authority to establish a board or committee.

5 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH Day**
6 **of AUGUST, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,525.50 FOR; 1,255.10**
7 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
8 **Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
9 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
10 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
11 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




