

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Bylaws of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-421

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation was established, in part, "to preserve,**
2 **protect and build upon our unique and distinctive culture and traditions"**
3 **(Constitution, Preamble); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "provide for,**
5 **appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of**
6 **committees, boards, officers and agents (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
7 **Article VI, Section 1(b)); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and its predecessor the Papago Tribe have historically**
9 **held a pageant to select young O'odham women to represent and serve the Nation as**
10 **its official ambassadors both on and off the Nation, and the Nation has annually**
11 **approved budgets to fund Miss Tohono O'odham Nation activities coordinated by the**
12 **Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee and the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Office;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the current Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee would benefit from bylaws**
15 **approved by the Legislative Council; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Chairperson in coordination with the Legislative Human Resources**
17 **Development Committee has developed the attached Bylaws of the Miss Tohono**
18 **O'odham Nation Committee which would provide for the organization and structure**
19 **and duties and responsibilities of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Human Resources Development Committee and the Rules Committee**
21 **have reviewed the Bylaws of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee and**
22 **recommend approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
24 **the Bylaws of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee in the form attached**
25 **hereto, provided that members currently serving on the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation**
26 **Committee shall continue to serve until their successors are appointed and qualified.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Bylaws adopted by this resolution shall supersede and replace**
28 **any previously approved bylaws of the Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee.**

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1 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
2 **of SEPTEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,579.90 FOR; -0-**
3 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 200.70[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
4 **by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
6 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
7 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


