

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing additional financial support to Arizonans for Tribal Government Gaming)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-440**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “consult, negotiate and conclude**  
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation with Federal, State**  
3 **and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or**  
4 **political subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within**  
5 **the authority of the Tohono O’odham Council” (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation and the State of Arizona have entered into a tribal-state gaming compact**  
8 **(the “Compact”); and**

9 **WHEREAS, consistent with the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2701 *et seq.*, the Compact**  
10 **recognizes “gaming by Indian tribes as a means of promoting tribal economic**  
11 **development, self-sufficiency, and strong tribal governments” (Compact, Declaration**  
12 **of Policy and Purpose); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Gaming Enterprise (“Gaming Enterprise”) has been established**  
14 **as an enterprise of the Nation to conduct gaming activities in accordance with the**  
15 **Compact; and**

16 **WHEREAS, as part of a comprehensive strategy to preserve existing tribal-state gaming compacts**  
17 **and to counter the current horse and dog track campaign to undermine tribal gaming,**  
18 **Arizona tribes have formed Arizonans for Tribal Government Gaming, a nonprofit**  
19 **corporation (“ATG2”); and**

20 **WHEREAS, by Resolution Nos. 09-449 and 10-224, the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council**  
21 **authorized the contribution of financial support to ATG2 through the Nation’s Gaming**  
22 **Enterprise; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Nation’s Chairperson and Legislative Commerce Committee recommend that the**  
24 **Nation contribute additional financial support to ATG2 in an amount not to exceed**  
25 **\$13,099.16; and that this amount be funded through the Gaming Enterprise.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
27 **supports and directs the Tohono O’odham Gaming Enterprise to remit payment in the**  
28 **amount of \$13,099.16 to Arizonans for Tribal Government Gaming.**



4 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
5 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
6 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
7 Stat. 984).


