

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2012 Budgets for Baboquivari District Administration and the  
Communities of Artesia-Little Tucson, Fresnal Canyon, Choulic, Coldfields,  
Topawa and South Komelic)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-452

1 WHEREAS, at a special session of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, held in September  
2 2011; and

3 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District officials presented their FY 2012 budgets for the District  
4 Administration, and the communities of Artesia-Little Tucson, Fresnal Canyon, Choulic,  
5 Coldfields, Topawa and South Komelic; and

6 WHEREAS, on July 20, 2011, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, per Resolution No. 11-307,  
7 approves to distribute gaming revenues to the Nation's District by equal distribution;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, on July 20, 2011, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, per Resolution No. 11-308,  
10 appropriated \$5,500,896.00 to be divided equally among the 11 districts; and

11 WHEREAS, by equal distribution, the Baboquivari District will receive an amount of \$1,660,996.79;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the Baboquivari District's  
14 Resolution No. 2010-B-94, to utilize a 40%/60% formula to distribute gaming revenues  
15 within their District; and

16 WHEREAS, utilizing this formula, \$664,398.71 is the calculated amount for Baboquivari District  
17 Administration budget at 40%; and

18 WHEREAS, utilizing this same formula, at 60%, the calculated amount of \$996,598.08 shall be  
19 divided equally to the six communities of Baboquivari District, for a distribution of  
20 \$166,099.68 per community; and

21 WHEREAS, the Topawa Community requests to carry forward their portion of Mining Royalties,  
22 per Baboquivari District Resolution No. 09-B-163, in the amount of \$17,741.37; and

23 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District has identified carry over dollars from previous years and will  
24 be utilizing these funds to supplement the FY 2012 budgets for the district  
25 administration and the six communities as follows:

7 **WHEREAS, the remaining balance of carry over funding in the amount of \$492,487.89 for the**  
8 **District Administration, \$217,220.59 for Fresno Canyon Community, \$255,184.84 for**  
9 **Topawa Community and \$232,772.72 for South Komelic Community will be utilized at**  
10 **later dates.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
12 **the FY 2012 budget of \$2,444,236.57, of which \$1,660,996.79 of equal distribution to**  
13 **districts, for the Baboquivari District Administration and the communities of Artesia-**  
14 **Little Tucson, Fresno Canyon, Choulic, Coldfields, Topawa and South Komelic,**  
15 **utilizing a formula of 40% to Baboquivari District Administration in the amount of**  
16 **\$664,398.71, and 60% to the six communities in the amount of \$996,598.08, divided**  
17 **equally, to the communities, in the amount of \$166,099.68 per community.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this budget will also include carry forward Mining Royalties of**  
19 **\$17,741.37 for Topawa Community and will include carry over dollars from previous**  
20 **years in the amount of \$765,498.41 for a total budget amount of \$2,444,236.57 for the**  
21 **Baboquivari District.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the remaining balance of carry over funding in the amount of**  
23 **\$492,487.89 for the District Administration; \$217,220.59 for Fresno Canyon**  
24 **Community; \$255,184.84 for Topawa Community and \$232,772.72 for South Komelic**  
25 **Community will be utilized at later dates.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
27 **District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budgets**  
28 **as attached provided, any modification, amendments, or changes in the justifications**  
29 **shall be reviewed and approved by the Budget and Finance Committee and the Tohono**  
30 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

31 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
32 **of SEPTEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
33 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
34 **Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
35 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
36 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
37 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


