

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Nation to Submit a P.L. 93-638 Proposal to Contract the Nation's
Tribal Shares of the Indian Health Service, Tucson Area Office HIV/AIDS Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-473

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **Tucson Area Indian Health Service (IHS) through P.L. 93-638 Contract No.**
3 **HHS1249200400001C, which includes an Annual Funding Agreement (AFA); and**

4 **WHEREAS, currently, the AFA provides HIV/AIDS funds to support the Community Counseling**
5 **and Relations Service (CCRS) which provides sexually transmitted disease (STD)**
6 **screening, outreach and education; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the proposed HIV/AIDS Disease Intervention and Surveillance Program is a new**
8 **program and will incorporate the CCRS activity into an enhanced STD intervention**
9 **and infectious disease surveillance, monitoring and assessment program, function,**
10 **and service activity (PFSA); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the geographical service areas is and will continue to be the greater Tohono**
12 **O'odham Reservation including San Xavier and San Lucy districts; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the beneficiaries of these services are members of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and**
14 **eligible members of other Federally recognized tribes, including the Sells Service**
15 **Unit users totaling more than 18,000; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the amount of funds requested for the new PFSA is approximately \$89,428.00; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and the Budget and Finance Committees of the**
18 **Legislative Council have reviewed this proposal to submit a new program proposal**
19 **to the Indian Health Service and recommend approval by the Legislative Council;**
20 **and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the proposal**
22 **and supports a modification or amendment to the Nation's P.L. 93-638 Contract with**
23 **IHS to contract for the program.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
25 **authorize the Nation to submit the P.L. 93-638 contract proposal for the Nation's**
26 **Tribal Shares of the Indian Health Service Tucson Area Office HIV/AIDS Program**
27 **funds and PFSA.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
29 **Chairperson of the Nation to negotiate and execute a modification or amendment**
30 **to the Nation's P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Indian Health Service to contract for the**
31 **HIV/AIDS program.**




