

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Nominating Representative Billman Lopez to the Indian Reservation Roads
Program Coordinating Committee)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-474

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult "federal**
2 **agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation" and**
3 **"to promote, protect, and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and**
4 **general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Article VI, Section**
5 **1(j) and 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Indian Reservation Roads ("IRR") Program Coordinating Committee provides**
7 **"input and recommendations to BIA and FHWA in developing IRR Program policies**
8 **and procedures" and supplements "government-to-government consultation by**
9 **coordinating with and obtaining input from tribes, BIA, and FHWA" (25 C.F.R.**
10 **§170.155(a)); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Coordinating Committee consists of 12 tribal regional representatives (one from**
12 **each BIA Region), with one alternate tribal member for each regional**
13 **representative, provided that each "tribal representative must be a tribal**
14 **governmental official or employee with authority to act for the tribal government"**
15 **(25 C.F.R. §170.155(b) and (c)); and**

16 **WHEREAS, Representative Frances G. Antone served as the IRR Coordinating Committee**
17 **Western Region tribal representative, but she is no longer a member of the**
18 **Legislative Council committee with oversight of roads and transportation; and**

19 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to nominate Representative Billman Lopez to serve**
20 **on the IRR Coordinating Committee.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

22 **(1) Nominates Representative Billman Lopez, who is a tribal governmental official**
23 **with authority to act for the tribal government, to serve as the IRR Coordinating**
24 **Committee Western Region tribal representative.**

25 **(2) Requests that the Secretary of the Interior appoint Representative Billman**
26 **Lopez to serve as the IRR Coordinating Committee Western Region tribal**
27 **representative.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the nomination made by this resolution shall supersede and**
29 **replace any previous Legislative Council nominations to the IRR Coordinating**
30 **Committee.**

31 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that an appointment made pursuant to this resolution shall**
32 **immediately expire if the appointee is no longer serving on the Legislative**
33 **Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee for any reason.**
