

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting Certification of Eligible Minor Members and Authorizing the Initial
Expenditure of Funds for Per Capita Payments under the Initiative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-504

1 **WHEREAS, on June 28, 1997 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the Nation) approved**
2 **Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"); and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Initiative authorized funding from Gaming Revenues for several measures,**
4 **including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000.00 to each member of the**
5 **Nation enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the Initial Per Capita Distribution); and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 97-451, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted**
7 **an Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan (the FIP) which authorized the**
8 **establishment of set-aside accounts for the Initial Per Capita Distribution and other**
9 **Initiative measures, and set certain conditions on the expenditure of funds from such**
10 **accounts; and**

11 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 97-478, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved**
12 **the transfer of funds from the Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated**
13 **set-aside accounts established at Bank of America, including the sum of \$41.5 million**
14 **to a set-aside for the Initial Per Capita Distribution (the Per Capita Account); and**

15 **WHEREAS, three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified in the FIP**
16 **are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a Per Capita Distribution plan (the**
17 **Revenue Allocation Plan) pursuant to the requirements of the Indian Gaming**
18 **Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. §2710 (b) (3); (2) acceptance by the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Legislative Council of a Certification of Eligible Members submitted by the**
20 **Enrollment Office and based upon receipt of a properly completed and filed**
21 **Certificate of Eligibility Verification for a Per Capita Payment for each member; and**
22 **(3) as to each Minor Eligible Member, establishment of a restricted account at Bank**
23 **of America for the deposit of such Member's Per Capita Payment; and**

24 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 97-452, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted**
25 **a Revenue Allocation Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the**
26 **Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with authority**
27 **delegated to the Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and**

28 **WHEREAS, by letter dated December 18, 1997 the Area Office approved the Revenue Allocation**
29 **Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and disapproved the Plan with**

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1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2000-472 the FIP was amended by Amendment No. 1 and**
2 **further amended by Amendment 2; and Amendment No. 2 requires an Agreement**
3 **with a reputable financial institution for the establishment of restricted accounts for**
4 **Minor Eligible Members; and**

5 **WHEREAS, an Agreement has been negotiated with Wells Fargo for the establishment of**
6 **restricted accounts for Minor Eligible Members; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has accepted and approved Certifications**
8 **of Eligible Members for the Initial Per Capita Distribution, and disbursements have**
9 **been made to such Members; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has filed with the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council a**
11 **Certification of Eligible Members listing 36 minors who are now eligible for receipt**
12 **of the Initial Per Capita Distribution as they are now adults; and**

13 **WHEREAS, all conditions under the applicable laws of the United States and the Nation have**
14 **been satisfied to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to the**
15 **Members listed in the Certification of Eligible Members.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 17 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the**
18 **Certification of Eligible Members, in the form attached hereto.**
- 19 **2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes Wells Fargo Bank to**
20 **commence payment of principal and investment income earned to the eligible**
21 **members identified in the form attached hereto as they are no longer restricted**
22 **beneficiaries.**
- 23 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to execute such other documents as**
24 **may be necessary to implement this Resolution.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH Day**
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2011 a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,553.90 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 226.70 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
28 **by Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
29 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
