

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Repealing Resolution No. 11-397 and Terminating Participation in the Strategic
Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-514

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority “to promote, protect and provide**
2 **for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono**
3 **O’odham Nation and its members” (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation’s Department of Health and Human Services Division of Management of**
5 **Health directs health services that provide substance abuse, mental health, and**
6 **prevention services to the Nation’s members; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Division of Management of Health submitted an application and received a grant**
8 **in the amount of \$600,800 per year for five years from the U. S. Department of Health**
9 **and Human Service Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration**
10 **(“SAMHSA”) for a Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant (“SPF TIG”);**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, by Resolutions No. 09-503, 10-198, and 11-240, the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council**
13 **authorized the acceptance of the grant each year and authorized the Tohono O’odham**
14 **Department of Health and Human Services to administer and expend grant funds; and**

15 **WHEREAS, in response to the SPF TIG requirement for the development and implementation of**
16 **the Tohono O’odham Nation’s Strategic Plan, the Nation’s Department of Health and**
17 **Human Services prepared two versions of the Strategic Plan; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Nation is unable to meet the SPF TIG requirements and it is**
19 **therefore in the Nation’s best interest to terminate its participation in the SPF TIG.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
21 **repeals Resolution No. 11-397 and withdraws its support of the Tohono O’odham**
22 **Nation Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant Strategic Plan 2011-**
23 **2013.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that on the effective date**
25 **of this resolution, the Council repeals its approvals of the Strategic Prevention**
26 **Framework Tribal Incentive Grant.**

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council revokes the authority to**
28 **expend any further funds under the FY 2012 SAMHSA SPF TIG budget; provided that the**
29 **Office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairwoman is authorized to pay any outstanding**



1 obligations incurred prior to the effective date of this resolution and to close out the
2 FY 2012 SAMHSA SPF TIG budget.

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairwoman is authorized to
4 communicate in writing the termination of the Nation's participation in the Strategic
5 Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant to the U. S. Department of Health and
6 Human Service Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.

7 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14th Day
8 of **NOVEMBER, 2011** at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of **2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
9 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT**, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
10 Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
11 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
12 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
13 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


