

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Grant Agreement No. 04-11-NA-761d with the United States
Department of the Interior-National Park Service)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-528

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") recognizes the need to protect, preserve and**
2 **manage cultural resources on its lands; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council established the Cultural Affairs Program in**
4 **1997 to assist with the aforementioned needs; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 08-249, in part to**
6 **approve the Nation's application to establish a Tribal Historic Preservation Office**
7 **("THPO") as part of the Nation's Cultural Affairs Program, pursuant to the National**
8 **Historic Preservation Act of 1966 ("NHPA") as amended (16 U.S.C. 470 *et seq.*); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation received notification from the National Park Service on September 4, 2009,**
10 **that the Nation's application to establish a THPO for the Nation was approved; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Nation received notification from the National Park Service on September 13,**
12 **2011, that its grant application to fund the Nation's THPO Office was approved in the**
13 **amount of \$84, 824.00 for FY 2012.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby approve Grant**
15 **Agreement 04-11-NA-761d, in substantially the form attached hereto, with the United**
16 **States Department of the Interior, National Park Service and approves the budget in**
17 **the amount of \$84,824.00 for FY 2012. The Cultural Affairs Office is authorized to**
18 **expend funds from the THPO account for operational purposes with the approved**
19 **budget.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
21 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
22 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
23 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15th Day**
25 **of NOVEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**

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


