**RESOLUTION NO. 11-539**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was awarded the Department of**  
2 **Justice Office of Justice Programs (DOJ) Sex Offender Registration, Tracking**  
3 **Enforcement and Notification Division Grant in the amount of \$221,173.00 under grant**  
4 **number AW-BX-0018; and**

5 **WHEREAS, this grant is a two year grant effective October 1, 2011 to March 31, 2013; and**

6 **WHEREAS, this grant has awarded Personnel cost to fund two position of Registration Compliance**  
7 **Officer and a Registration/Victim Notification Specialist and Operational Cost which**  
8 **a FY 2012 budget was created in the amount of \$149,819.30; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this grant allows for Indirect Cost and has been budgeted at the approved rate of**  
10 **\$18.82%; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the attached award documents and budget has been reviewed by the Budget Office,**  
12 **Grants & Contracts, Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget &**  
13 **Finance Committee, of all which recommend acceptance by the Tohono O'odham**  
14 **Legislative Council.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
16 **accepts the Department of Justice Programs Sex Offender Registration, Tracking**  
17 **Enforcement and Notification Division Grant in the amount of \$221,173.00 a two year**  
18 **grant to which the TONPD has created a FY 2012 budget in the amount of \$149,819.30**  
19 **that includes Indirect Cost.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
21 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
22 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
23 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>th</sup> Day**  
25 **of NOVEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
30 **Stat. 984).**


