1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has been awarded the Department of**
2 **Justice Office of Justice Programs Tohono O'odham Nation Project Safe**
3 **Neighborhoods Initiative grant in the amount of \$150,000.00, grant number 2011-GP-**
4 **BX-0030; and**

5 **WHEREAS, this grant is a two year period grant from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2013; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has prepared a budget in the amount**
7 **of \$150,000.00 which has been reviewed by the Budget Office, Grants & Contracts,**
8 **Executive Office, Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of all**
9 **which recommend acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this grant does not require Indirect Cost.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
12 **accepts the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs Tohono O'odham Nation**
13 **Project Safe Neighborhoods Initiative grant in the amount of \$150,000.00 under grant**
14 **number 2011-GP-BX-0030 and approves the FY 2012 budget as attached and to utilize**
15 **the Nation's resources pending reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation**
16 **of grant.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
18 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
19 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
20 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17th Day**
22 **of NOVEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
27 **Stat. 984).**






