

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Legislative Order No. 11-518 for Roll Call to Begin at 10 a.m.)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 11-543

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to
2 regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards
3 and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
4 Section 1(a)); and

5 WHEREAS, Article I, Section 2.,(C) of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
6 Council, as amended, provides that "[a]ll Legislative Council sessions shall be held at
7 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council chambers located in Sells, Tohono O'odham
8 Nation, with the following exceptions. . . . [a] majority of all the legislative
9 representatives may vote to hold a session in some location other than the chambers
10 located at Sells."; and


11 WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 11-518, the Legislative Council approved holding the morning
12 portion of its November 18, 2011 general session at the Baboquivari High School in
13 order to attend "Teen Hall" with roll call beginning at 9 a.m.; and

14 WHEREAS, the "Teen Hall" won't begin until 10 a.m. and the Human Resources Development
15 Committee recommends amending Legislative Order No. 11-518 for roll call to begin
16 at 10 a.m.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it amends
18 Legislative Order No. 11-518 for roll call to begin at 10 a.m.

19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH day of
20 NOVEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-
21 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
22 VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
23 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
25 Stat. 984).


