

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Adopting November 2011 Amendment to the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki**  
**Association Ordinance)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-559

1 **WHEREAS, Article VI , Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the**  
2 **Legislative Council with the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for**  
3 **public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham**  
4 **Nation and its members"; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council established the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") as**  
6 **a separate tribal entity in accordance with Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**  
7 **O'odham Nation and pursuant to Legislative Council Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended**  
8 **("TOKA Ordinance"), 18 T.O.C. Ch. 1, [www.tolc-nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf](http://www.tolc-nsn.org/docs/Title18Ch1.pdf)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Housing Committee is delegated legislative oversight of the TOKA and**  
10 **the Committee has proposed numerous TOKA Ordinance amendments to improve**  
11 **TOKA operations (Plan of Operation for the Housing Committee; Resolutions No. 02-**  
12 **089, No. 02-110, No. 06-440, No. 10-019, No. 11-191); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Committee has proposed an amendment to the TOKA Ordinance to strengthen the**  
14 **expertise and overall performance of the TOKA Board of Directors dated November**  
15 **2011 for reference; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the proposed TOKA Ordinance amendment was distributed for public comment and**  
17 **posted on the Legislative Branch website on October 18, 2011; and**

18 **WHEREAS, following a 30-day public comment period with no public comments submitted, the**  
19 **Housing Committee recommends approval of the November 2011 amendment to the**  
20 **TOKA Ordinance; and**

21 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to adopt the November 2011 amendment to the TOKA**  
22 **Ordinance.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby adopts the November 2011**  
24 **amendment to the TOKA Ordinance.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>ST</sup> Day**  
26 **of NOVEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,873.70 FOR; 906.90**  
27 **AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






