

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Designating December 8, 2011 General Session to Recognize Mr. Joseph T. Joaquin,
2011 Living Treasure Awardee)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 11-565

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures to**
2 **regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards**
3 **and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 11-304, the Legislative Council nominated Mr. Joseph T. Joaquin as**
6 **a recipient for the 2011 Arizona Indian Living Treasure Award for his lifetime**
7 **achievements in preserving the O'odham language and culture; and**


8 **WHEREAS, on October 15, 2011, Arizona Indian Living Treasures Awards, Inc. ("AILTA") held a**
9 **ceremony to recognize Mr. Joaquin and other recipients of the distinguished 2011**
10 **Living Treasures Award; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee has recommended that the Legislative Council**
12 **designate December 8, 2011 of the December general session as a day to celebrate and**
13 **honor AILTA awardee Mr. Joseph Joaquin with scheduled activities.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Legislative**
15 **Council hereby designates December 8, 2011 as a day to celebrate and honor AILTA**
16 **awardee Mr. Joseph T. Joaquin for his lifetime achievements in language and cultural**
17 **preservation, provided that the celebration will be the only item on the Council's**
18 **agenda that day.**

19 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02ND day of**
20 **DECEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
22 **VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**
