

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval for Seth Schermerhorn to Perform Research and Educational Outreach on the Tohono O'odham Nation as Part of His Ph.D. Dissertation on the Pilgrimage to Magdalena)

RESOLUTION NO. 11-579

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the**
2 **power "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education**
3 **and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Mr. Schermerhorn is a Ph.D. student with several years of experience and service**
6 **working with the Tohono O'odham through social and cultural activities on the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Nation, including but not limited to walking to Magdalena for the**
8 **past three years and studying the O'odham language at Tohono O'odham Community**
9 **College, resulting in a basic understanding of the O'odham language and a sensitivity**
10 **to Tohono O'odham cultural concerns; and**

11 **WHEREAS, on November 22, 2011 and December 5, 2011, Mr. Schermerhorn presented his**
12 **proposed Ph.D. dissertation project (interviews, informal discussion, observation,**
13 **archival work) on the pilgrimage to Magdalena, which involves conducting research**
14 **on the Tohono O'odham Nation, to the Cultural Preservation Committee and the**
15 **Human Resources Development Committee; and**

16 **WHEREAS, Mr. Schermerhorn's project will study the pilgrimage to Magdalena to better**
17 **understand the history of the pilgrimage and produce knowledge that can be utilized**
18 **to develop culturally responsive curriculum to be taught at institutions serving**
19 **Tohono O'odham and other American Indian students; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the proposed project includes an educational outreach and curriculum development**
21 **project for the Tohono O'odham Nation Cultural Center and Museum; and**

22 **WHEREAS, Mr. Schermerhorn has received a letter of support from the Tohono O'odham Nation**
23 **Cultural Center and Museum; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the research proposal has been reviewed by the Cultural Preservation and Human**
25 **Resources Development committees.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
27 **approves the proposal from Seth Schermerhorn to conduct research on the Tohono**
28 **O'odham Nation on the pilgrimage to Magdalena as part of his Ph.D. dissertation,**
29 **provided that Mr. Schermerhorn shall:**

30 **1. Conduct research activities, including interviews, informal discussion,**


observation, archival work in accordance with all applicable research standards including research involving human subjects.

2. Disclose to project participants how the information will be used and the potential for publication of such information and obtain informed consent of the participants.
3. Provide updates on the project to the Cultural Preservation and Human Resources Development committees and to the Tohono O'odham Nation Cultural Center and Museum.
4. Provide copies of the dissertation to interested libraries on the Nation and provide curriculum developed, data collected, and copies of any transcript or recordings from the project to appropriate locations on the Tohono O'odham Nation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any and all data is the property of the Tohono O'odham Nation; the Tohono O'odham Nation Museum and Cultural Center will be the guardian of this data, which will be held within their archives.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day of DECEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,782.60 FOR; 998.0 AGAINST; [02] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




