

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Representative Ethel Garcia and Representative Pamela Anghill to the
U.S.-Mexico Border 2012 and Border 2020 Environmental Programs)**

RESOLUTION NO. 11-586

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to manage, protect,**
2 **and preserve the property, wildlife, water, land, air, and natural and cultural**
3 **resources of the Tohono O'odham Nation (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(i)(2) and Articles XVI, XVII, and XVIII); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Council is further vested with the power to "consult, negotiate, and conclude**
6 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State**
7 **and local governments and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or**
8 **political subdivisions" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section**
9 **1(f); and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Nation has been an active participant in the U.S.-Mexico Border XXI and Border**
11 **2012 environmental programs implemented under the 1983 La Paz Agreement and**
12 **administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") and Mexico's**
13 **Secretariat for the Environment and Natural Resources ("SEMARNAT") to address**
14 **environmental and public health problems in the U.S.-Mexico border regions and**
15 **communities; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation is represented by the Arizona-Sonora Regional Workgroup, one of four**
17 **regional workgroups within the Border 2012 framework, and has actively participated**
18 **in task forces established to address priorities and projects identified for the Arizona-**
19 **Sonora region, including projects benefiting the Nation and its members on both sides**
20 **of the international boundary; and**

21 **WHEREAS, EPA and SEMARNAT has announced and solicited comments on the next, eight-year**
22 **"Border 2020: U.S.-Mexico Environmental Program" which will succeed the current 10-**
23 **year Border 2012 program; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Domestic Affairs Committee is vested with oversight of environmental**
25 **issues on the Nation and recommends appointing Representative Ethel Garcia to the**
26 **U.S.-Mexico Border 2012 and Border 2020 Environmental Programs and appointing**
27 **Representative Pamela Anghill to serve as alternate to Representative Ethel Garcia.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints**
29 **Representative Ethel Garcia as the Nation's representative to the Arizona-Sonora**


1 **Regional Workgroup for the U.S.-Mexico Border 2012 and Border 2020 Environmental**

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointment made by this resolution shall supersede all prior**
5 **appointments to the U.S.-Mexico Border 2012 and Border 2020 Environmental**
6 **Programs.**

7 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any appointment made pursuant to this resolution shall**
8 **immediately expire if the appointed representative no longer serves on the Legislative**
9 **Domestic Affairs Committee.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH Day**
11 **of DECEMBER, 2011 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,780.60 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
13 **1 (f) and (i)(2) of Article VI and Articles XVI, XVII, and XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono**
14 **O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by**
15 **the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
16 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


