

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Designating Representative Leander V. Mase as the Nation's Representative on the
Pima County Safety and Justice Challenge Community Collaborative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-132

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the authority “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments**
4 **and other Indian tribes . . . or with private persons or organizations on all matters**
5 **within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council” and to “promote, protect**
6 **and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of**
7 **the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members”;** (Constitution, Article VI, Section
8 **1(f) and Section 1(c)(2)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, Pima County was awarded a \$1.5 million grant in 2016 from the John D. and**
10 **Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation's Safety and Justice Challenge to fund**
11 **strategies and programs designed to safely reduce the jail population and reduce**
12 **racial and ethnic disparities in the criminal justice system; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Pima County has invited the Tohono O'odham Nation to designate a**
14 **representative to participate on the 33-member Safety and Justice Challenge**
15 **Community Collaborative which was formed to provide advice on strategies to**
16 **reduce incarceration and help evaluate the Challenge's progress; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Community Collaborative is composed of members with broad experience in**
18 **the criminal justice system, including formerly incarcerated men and women,**
19 **family members impacted by incarceration, victim advocates, judges, law**
20 **enforcement, prosecutors, defense attorneys, court personnel, and tribal**
21 **representatives; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Judiciary Committees recommend designating**
23 **Representative Leander V. Mase as the Nation's Representative on the Pima**
24 **County Safety and Justice Challenge Community Collaborative.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council designates**
26 **Representative Leander V. Mase as the Nation's Representative on the Pima**
27 **County Safety and Justice Challenge Community Collaborative; provided that the**
28 **designation made pursuant to this resolution shall expire if Representative Mase**
29 **is no longer serving on the Legislative Domestic Affairs and Judiciary Committees**
