

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting the U.S. Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring
Program Grant No Cost Extension and Approving the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety
Police Department U. S. Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services
Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-134

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the United States Department of Justice**
8 **("DOJ") Office of Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") Hiring Program**
9 **Grant, Award No. 2014UMWX0024, effective September 1, 2014 through August 31,**
10 **2017 in the amount of \$125,000.00, which was accepted by Resolution No. 14-545;**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, the DOJ granted a 40-month no cost extension of the COPS Hiring Program Grant**
13 **effective August 21, 2017 through December 31, 2020; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety Police Department has prepared and submitted**
15 **for review and approval its FY 2018 DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security**
16 **Grant Budget in the amount of \$125,000.00, which is incorporated by this**
17 **reference, and which is cost shared with the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety**
18 **Police Department Law Enforcement Budget; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
20 **2018 Department of Public Safety Police Department DOJ COPS Hiring Program**
21 **Homeland Security Grant Budget and recommend its approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**
23 **40-month no cost extension of the DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant, effective**
24 **September 1, 2017 through December 31, 2020.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2018**
26 **Department of Public Safety Police Department DOJ COPS Hiring Program**
27 **Homeland Security Grant Budget effective September 1, 2017 in the amount of**
28 **\$125,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending**
29 **reimbursement by the grantor.**

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
3 expend the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety Police Department U. S.
4 Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program
5 Homeland Security Grant Budget, provided however, that any amendments or
6 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
7 Legislative Council.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH
9 day of APRIL, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-
10 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
11 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
12 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
13 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
14 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


