

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2018 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice,  
Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-135**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the United States Department of Justice**  
8 **("DOJ"), Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") Hiring Program Grant,**  
9 **Award No. 2013-UM-WX-0010, effective September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2016**  
10 **in the amount of \$125,000.00, which was accepted by Resolution No. 14-062; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the DOJ granted a 30-month no cost extension of the COPS Hiring Program Grant,**  
12 **effective August 21, 2016 through February 28, 2019, which was accepted by**  
13 **Resolution No. 17-105; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety prepared and submitted for review and approval**  
15 **its FY 2018 DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant Budget, which is incorporated by this**  
16 **reference, in the amount of \$125,000.00, and which is funded by the DOJ COPS**  
17 **Hiring Program Grant and the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety Police**  
18 **Department's Law Enforcement Budget; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
20 **2018 Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Hiring Program Budget and**  
21 **recommend its approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
23 **FY 2018 Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Hiring Program Budget effective**  
24 **October 1, 2017 in the amount of \$125,000.00 to be funded by the DOJ COPS Hiring**  
25 **Program Grant and the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety Police Department's**  
26 **Law Enforcement Budget.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
28 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
29 **expend the FY 2018 Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Hiring Program**  
30 **Budget, provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be**  
31 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
