

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Endorsing Representative Sally Ann Gonzales for Arizona Senate)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-190**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**  
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments"**  
4 **and to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education**  
5 **and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**  
6 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f) and Section 1(c)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, Representative Sally Ann Gonzales, a member of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe who is**  
8 **currently a member of the Arizona House of Representatives representing**  
9 **District 3 in Southern Arizona, is running for the Arizona Senate and requesting**  
10 **support from the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Representative Sally Ann Gonzales has advocated for health, education, rural**  
12 **development, and tribal issues at the Arizona State Legislature on behalf of her**  
13 **constituents in District 3 with recognition of Arizona's indigenous citizens,**  
14 **including members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Arizona Legislative District 3 is adjacent to the district in which most of the**  
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation is located, District 4, and as a result Representative Sally**  
17 **Ann Gonzales is familiar with and has supported the Nation's issues; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee met with Representative Sally Ann Gonzales,**  
19 **discussed the Nation's issues, and recommends endorsing her for the Arizona**  
20 **Senate, provided that the Legislative Council encourages Nation's members to**  
21 **vote as they deem appropriate.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council endorses**  
23 **Representative Sally Ann Gonzales for the Arizona Senate.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>**  
25 **day of JUNE, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
27 **Article VI, Section 1(f) and 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
28 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
