

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental  
Agreement Amendment No. 3 between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the  
Arizona Department of Economic Security)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-209**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the power to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**  
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments**  
4 **and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions,**  
5 **or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the**  
6 **Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") is a federally**  
8 **funded program, administered through the Arizona Department of Economic**  
9 **Security ("ADES"), that helps low-income households pay their heating and**  
10 **cooling bills, minimize crises, and make energy costs more affordable; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the LIHEAP Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") between the Nation and ADES**  
12 **was approved by Resolution No. 16-212 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June**  
13 **30, 2020 and which will provide funding to the Nation for the LIHEAP on an annual**  
14 **basis in the amount of \$62,572.00; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the ADES has submitted LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 3 to add the Case**  
16 **Management Service Budget to the IGA for the period of July 1, 2018 through June**  
17 **30, 2019 in the amount of \$62,572.00; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have**  
19 **reviewed LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 3 and recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
21 **LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 3 and authorizes the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
22 **chairperson to execute the LIHEAP IGA Amendment No. 3 in substantially the**  
23 **form attached, provided that any further modifications or amendments shall be**  
24 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of JUNE, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,853.5 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 231.1 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
28 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
