

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Tabling E.E.O.C. Grant - Refer to Budget & Finance Committee)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 259-90

1 WHEREAS, on August 7, 1990, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 addressed the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission
3 (E.E.O.C.) FY '91 grant budget for the Nation's T.E.R.O.
4 Program; and

5 WHEREAS, historically the grant is at an established amount of
6 \$22,500 which excludes indirect cost; and

7 WHEREAS, the grant budget, excluding indirect cost, was reviewed
8 by the Judiciary and Budget & Finance Committees and was
9 recommended for approval; and

10 WHEREAS, the ongoing position of the Budget & Finance Committee has
11 been to recoup indirect costs from the funding agencies
12 for grants and contracts which the Nation submits applica-
13 tion to; and

14 WHEREAS, the E.E.O.C. grant, as presented, included a draft
15 resolution requesting the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16 Council to waive the indirect cost for this grant.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
18 Council that it hereby tables action on the E.E.O.C. grant
19 budget.


20 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the request for the indirect cost waiver
21 on the E.E.O.C. grant be referred to the Budget & Finance
22 Committee for recommendation.

23 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
24 7th day of August, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
25 with a vote of 1,294.5 for; -0- against; 429.5 not voting; 04
26 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
27 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
29 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
30 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
31 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
